What is the Lutheran Witness magazine?



The Recipe Corner: Eclair Dessert Squares

(Cinda Knight, family favorite)

Ingredients:

3 pkg French Vanilla Instant Pudding 4½ c. Milk

Graham crackers

9 Oz. Cool Whip and $\frac{1}{2}$ of another 9 oz. Carton Line bottom of buttered 9x13-inch pan with whole graham crackers. Make pudding using $4\frac{1}{2}$ cups milk. Fold in Cool Whip. Pour half over crackers; lay another layer of crackers and pour remaining pudding over crackers. Put a layer of crackers on top.

Spread with Chocolate Icing:

- 2 sq. Baker's chocolate, melted
 - 2 Tbs butter, melted
 - 2 Tbs corn syrup
 - 1 tsp vanilla
 - 1¹/₂ cups powdered sugar
- 3 Tbs milk
