#### From Martin Luther's Small Catechism...

A "catechism" is a book for teaching, usually in the form of questions and answers. We study the catechism (and the Scriptures!) all during our life.

The Lord's Prayer: The First Petition Hallowed be Thy Name.

What does this mean? God's name is certainly holy in itself, but we pray in this petition that it may be kept holy among us also.

How is God's name kept holy? God's name is kept holy when the Word of God is taught in its truth and purity, and we, as the children of God, also lead holy lives according to it. Help us do

this, dear Father in heaven. But anyone who teaches or lives contrary to God's Word profanes the name of God among us. Protect us from this, heavenly Father!

## New Bible Study Opportunity: Reformation Recap

On June 25<sup>th</sup> 1530, the Imperial Diet (meeting) at Augsburg was held to resolve "the German problem" in the Roman Catholic Church. This year marks the 495<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the date when Martin Luther and his like-minded German theologians presented the Augsburg Confession, a summary of what they believed, taught, and confessed.

On the five Wednesdays of October, at St. Paul – Kalkaska, Pastor will lead a study of the main events and controversies of the Protestant Reformation and the rise of the Lutheran Church. This one-hour class will begin at 6:30pm to encourage folks to attend who work during the daytime. Everyone is welcome, we hope you will join us!

½ c. butter or margarine

21/4 c. flour

1 T. sugar

3½ t. baking powder

1½ t. salt

<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> c. milk

Grated parmesan cheese for topping (optional) Preheat oven to 450. Put butter or margarine in 9"x13" baking dish and place in preheating oven to melt. When the butter is melted, combine remaining ingredients in a mixing bowl. On a floured board pat dough out to ½" thick and cut into 1" strips about 5" long (a pizza cutter works great for this). Dip each strip in the melted butter, turning to coat all sides, then place side-by-side in the baking dish. If desired,

sprinkle with parmesan. Bake 15-20 minutes, or until golden brown on top. Serve them with stew or chili or soup or anytime you would serve biscuits.
